



Online language workshop: Revise, Review, Rewrite – How to edit your academic texts as a non-native speaker

One-day Language Workshop on Academic Writing in English

Take your research writing the extra mile – acquire new editing skills and proofreading strategies to improve your paper's style, cohesion, clarity and punctuation. This **online workshop** will provide you with input on how to better prepare your paper for publication or peer-review.

We will make use of digital materials, handouts and exercises. The online workshop will take place in a classroom environment and include interactive group activities that will augment the trainer's input.

In the second phase of the online workshop, you will be invited to take part in a **one-on-one consultation with the trainer (ca. 30 minutes)**. This optional consultation usually takes place in the week following the workshop and offers you the chance to look more closely at your own writing from a linguistic perspective and get suggestions on how to continue the process of becoming a better proof-reader and writer.

You are most welcome – indeed encouraged – to bring along samples of your own academic writing in English. These need not be polished excerpts or whole texts; works in progress are just as welcome, and sometimes even better suited for trying out new strategies.
